TEMPERATURE
(at bureau of meteorology)

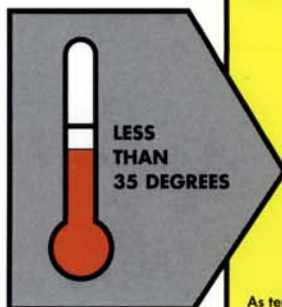
EXPOSED AREAS

Areas subject to general outside temperature eg. exposed formwork decks, outside work etc.

LESS EXPOSED AREAS

Areas clearly cooler than the general outside temperature: eg. lower levels of multi-storey buildings, inside or shaded areas, basements etc.

AIR-CONDITIONED AREAS



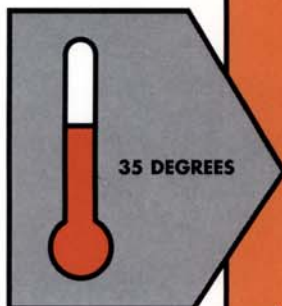
WORK CONTINUES NORMALLY BUT

As temperature rises:

- Actions taken to minimise heat discomfort and stress
- Workers progressively transferred to appropriate work in less exposed areas

ALL WORK IN EXPOSED AREAS CEASES

Any workers not transferred to work in less exposed areas, transfer to air-conditioned amenities. (Any workers required to remain in exposed areas to complete concrete pours, emergency work or to service workers in less exposed areas are entitled to double time rates.)

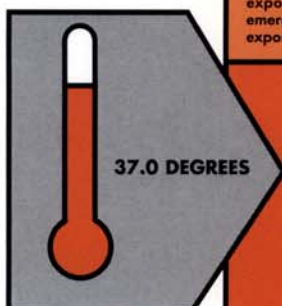
WORK CONTINUES NORMALLY BUT

If workers in amenities leave site under one of the conditions listed then workers in less exposed areas not required to work the last hour.

AMENITIES

- More than total 4hrs
- More than 50% of afternoon
- More than 50% of last 2hrs
